Whiteflies typically feed on the undersides of plant leaves. Whiteflies feed by tapping into the phloem of plants, introducing toxic saliva, and decreasing the plants' overall turgor pressure.

Aphids are small sap-sucking insects and members of the superfamily Aphidoidea. Common names include greenfly and blackfly, although individuals within a species can vary widely in color. As sap feeders, they damage crops and reduce yields, but as plant virus vectors, they have a more devastating impact. The transmission of these viruses depends on the movements of aphids between different parts of a plant, between nearby plants, and further afield.

Grapes	250 ml - 400 ml	Bud Busting
Vegetables	250 ml	Time of Cultivation
