**THE MOST EFFICIENT FOR Control of Leaf Miner**

A leaf miner is any one of numerous species of insects in which the larval stage lives, and eats, the leaf tissue of plants. Like woodboring beetles, leaf miners are protected from many predators and plant defenses by feeding within the tissues of the leaves, selectively eating only the layers that have the least amount of cellulose. The pattern of the feeding tunnel and the layer of the leaf being mined is often diagnostic of the insect responsible, sometimes even to species level. Some mining insects feed in other parts of a plant, such as the surface of a fruit or the petals of a flower.
